





## **CINQUETERRE**

WHITE DOC

Produced from grapes grown on terraced vineyards, by the sea, in the municipalities of Riomaggiore, Manarola and Vernazza where local varieties such as Bosco, Vermentino, Albarola and Ruzzese are mostly grown.

The total planted area is about 1.5 ha, divided into 5 different parcels. The soils are acidic due to the breaking down of schists and micaschists. The 80 year old vines are trained on pergolas at one meter from the ground and a planting density of about 4,000 vines/ha while the newest planting are trained on a modified "alberello" (bush vines) with a density of 11,000 vines/ha.

Harvest is carried out in the second half of September. After a short maceration on the skins, the grapes are fermented in stainless steel and aged on their lees for the following 6 months. The yield is  $5\,\text{t/ha}$ .

The tannic structure of the variety Bosco together with the aromas of Vermentino meet the acidity of Albarola and Ruzzese in a naturally balanced mix that makes these wines full and elegant.

Of all the parcels, the "Costa da Posa" is absolutely worth mentioning as a true natural amphitheatre of pre-Roman origin with dry-stone retaining walls built 1000 years ago.
